# **ESSENTIAL INFO**

#### **TOILETS**

Toilets are located inside the Palace and on the South Terrace. Please note, due to the slope and to protect plants and wildlife, there are no toilets on the south slope.

### **ACCESSIBILITY**

Most event areas are accessible, but please be aware that much of the parkland is set on a slope. Accessible routes to the main stage are available, please refer to the Accessibility Map (available at the information points). There is an accessible viewing platform by the main stage – this operates on a first come, first served basis.

#### WATER

Free tap water is available at the bars.

#### CASH

Take cash out before you arrive. There are cash machines inside the event but these will charge and will be busy.

## FIRST AID

Two first aid points are located within the parklands, see map. Medics will also be patrolling the site.

## STROBES AND SFX

Strobes will be used on some of the performances.

## **OUR NEIGHBOURS**

Please respect our neighbours by leaving quietly and use the bins provided.

### TRANSPORT

By rail: Alexandra Palace is located on the east side of the Park. Regular trains run from Kings Cross Station and Finsbury Park and head north towards Stevenage and Welwyn Garden City.

By underground: The nearest underground station is Wood Green on the Piccadilly Line.

### RESTRICTED ITEMS

Thorough bag searches will be in place at all entrance gates and a number of items are not allowed on site including alcohol, glass, food & soft drinks (other than that is reasonable for personal consumption), illegal substances or 'legal' highs. A full list can be found at
